

Jase Magers Memorial Scholarship
(Draft August 2014)

Jase Magers became the Lady Panthers Soccer Coach in 1995 after graduating from Stephen F. Austin State University. He built the Lady Panthers into a viable soccer program, which made the high school, town, and soccer players proud. He loved soccer, kids, and life plus provided a positive role model for all who knew him.

The Jase Magers Memorial Scholarship was established in May of 1999 following Jase's death. It is funded by the Lady Panthers Soccer Booster Club and friends of Jas Magers. The scholarship is a privilege and must be earned with team participation, grade, and by volunteering time to the booster club for the good of the team.

The JMM Scholarship is paid as a lump sum directly to the university of the recipient. The Lady Panthers Soccer Booster Club Scholarship committee establishes the amount of the scholarship each year.

The Lady Panthers Soccer Booster Club handles the administration of the soccer scholarship fund and has established the following criteria for selection:

1. Completed Scholarship Application prior to deadline. This will be turned in to a third party at LHS. If the application is not turned in by the deadline, the soccer player is no longer eligible for the scholarship.
2. The soccer player must be a member of the Lady Panthers Soccer team for at least 3 years; one of those years must be their senior year. The player must finish in good standing.
3. The soccer player must demonstrate strong leadership skills, provide a positive role model, and make a major contribution to the team with input from LISD staff.
4. The soccer player must maintain a "B" average or better while in the soccer program.
5. The soccer player must display a positive attitude toward team unity and a true love of the sport with input from LISD staff.
6. The soccer player must work a minimum of 6 hour for each year they are in the soccer program. These hours may be fulfilled by the parent, guardian, and/or student and will be

recorded each year. Hours must be approved and documented through the Lady Panthers Soccer Booster Club.

7. The scholarship will be revoked if the paper work for the university is not turned in on time to the treasurer.
8. If a player transfers in, a percentage of the scholarship money available will be given if the player meets all other requirements. For example, if a player participates their senior year and meets all requirements listed, they will receive 1/3 of the amount available to each player. If a player participates for 2 years and meets all other requirements, they will receive 2/3 of the amount available to each player.
9. The third party will receive the applications and review hours worked and grades and give their recommendations to the scholarship committee. The coaches will also submit their recommendations as well. The final decision is made by the scholarship committee and approved by the Lady Panther Soccer Booster club. Interviews may be necessary in some circumstances.
